On the directions of Mandeep Kaur, IAS, Commissioner, JMC, Dr. Zaffar Iqbal, Municipal Veterinary Officer along with staff of cattle pond launched the drive against illegal dairies running within the limits of JMC today on 02.03.2016.

The drive was launched from Sarwal area and on spot one dairy near Justice Bhat lane, Lower Laxmi Nagar Sarwal has been closed by the team of JMC and the owner shifted all the cattle to the remote area. Further, the team lifted the livestock of the dairy running at Sarwal near graveyard and impounded these cattle at Dogra Hall, Jammu as the disposal of this dairy is directly into public drain creating insanitary conditions in and around the dairy and also made cruelty to these animals.

Team also set free the birds (Parrots etc) kept in the cages by the owners Rorain di Chapri, Jamipur Jammu and booked the defaulter under law.

The drive will remain continue till all the dairy units are not registered with the Corporation. Jammu Municipal Corporation appeals to the owners of the dairy units for registration of their dairies immediately otherwise their cattle shall be seized and impounded in cattle pond.





## **JMC SEALES ANOTHER PREMISES IN GANDHI NAGAR**

On the instruction of Ms. Mandeep Kaur IAS, Commissioner Jammu Municipal Corporation and under the supervision of Sh. R.S Jamwal KAS Joint Commissioner (Adm), the Enforcement Staff led by the Enforcement Officer Jammu Municipal Corporation sealed the premises at 47 C/C Gandhi Nagar, Jammu where a coaching centre namely CHANKAYA IAS Academy has been opened in violation of the status quo order of the Hon'ble High Court and also in violation of the land use of the area from residential to commercial one. The said illegal construction seriously effects the planned development of Jammu City and contravenes the zoning regulation and also the said commercial activity causes traffic problems in the vicinity much to the inconvenience of the neighbourers residing in the locality. The action has been taken under section 8 (1) of J&K Control of Building Operation Act, 1988. The sealing operation has been conducted with the help of Police Assistance from Police Station Gandhi Nagar and from District Police Lines, Jammu.

The Jammu Municipal Corporation appeals to General Public to refrain from making encroachments and unauthorized constructions otherwise action as admissible under rule leading to demolition / sealing will be taken.

The Municipal Veterinary Officer/Zonal Officer-II, (Sanitation) Dr. Zafar Iqbal along with field staff on the directions of Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation, Ms. Mandeep Kaur, IAS conducted a meat drive especially on the eve of Maha shiv Ratri in the areas B.C. Road, New Plot, Janipur, Talab Tillo, Roop Nagar, Muthi, Bohri etc.

While checking meat shops about 62 Kg of un-stamped/sub-standard meat was checked and discarded on spot by proper way as well as 10 kg of polythene carry bags was seized and fine to the tune of Rs. 5300/- has been realized from the defaulters.

#### **JMC sealed two meat shops at Company Bagh & Hyderapura, Janipur, Jammu**

Due to rapidly increasing illegal slaughtering of animals in the different areas of the Jammu city and to control over this illegal practice going on since long Municipal Veterinary Officer/Zonal Officer-II, (Sanitation) Dr. Zafar Iqbal along with field staff on the directions of Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation, Ms. Mandeep Kaur, IAS conducted a special meat drive in the areas of Janipur & Company Bagh near MAM Stadium etc.

While on checking the team of veterinary wing inspected numerous meat shops especially those dealing with selling of un-stamped/sub-standard meat and buying meat from illegal slaughtering. It has been also observed that these shops do not maintain hygienic environment in the premises as well as surroundings, JMC team warned them and directed to ensure the proper hygienic environment within the premises and surroundings.

Beside this, the Veterinary wing of JMC sealed two shops one at Company Bagh and one at Hyderapura, Janipur for performing illegal slaughtering of animals.

The drive will continue in near future against the illegal slaughtering running in the market are strictly warned to stop this practice of illegal slaughtering and directed to ensure the supply of good quality and hygienic meat to the Citizens of Jammu City.

#### **JMC demolishes the unauthorizedly built Flats at Channi Rama, Jammu.**

While continuing the drive vigorously against the unauthorized constructions within the jurisdiction of Jammu Municipal Corporation, Ms. Mandeep Kaur, IAS, Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation herself led the squad alongwith Sh. R. S. Jamwal, KAS, Joint Commissioner (A) and other senior officers and demolished the Trident Flats at Channi Rama, Jammu by pressing the men and machinery into service which have been raised unauthorizedly, as the construction raised was in gross violation of the building plans approved which was initially accorded for the construction of houses but the violators raised the multiple flats without the permission of Jammu Municipal Corporation. Thereafter, the premises was also sealed under section 8(1) of J&K Control of Building Operation Act, 1988. The Jammu Municipal Corporation had already proceed against the violators namely Sh. Rahat Afridi S/o Sh. Israr Khan and Smt. Nighat Afridi w/o Sh. Israr Khan under the provisions of J&K Control of Building Operation Act, 1988. The demolition and sealing operation has been conducted with the help and active cooperation of police force from police station, Channi Himmat, Jammu.

The Jammu Municipal Corporation had also given the public notice in the leading newspapers asking the general public not to purchase the flats in Trident being the unauthorized ones at Channi Rama near Nidheesh Apartment, Jammu. As per the approved building bye laws-2011 the builder is required to get the completion/occupancy certificate from the Jammu Municipal Corporation before putting the building in use. The sewer/water/electricity connection shall be given to the builder by the respective departments only on the production of completion/occupancy certificate from Jammu Municipal Corporation.

The Jammu Municipal Corporation appeals to the general public to refrain from raising unauthorized constructions failing which the penal action which may lead to sealing/demolition of unauthorized constructions.

**Ms. Mandeep Kaur, IAS, Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation reviewed the functioning/upgradation of existing and installation of intelligent traffic management system.**

Today on 18.03.2016, a meeting was held under the chairmanship of Municipal Commissioner, Mandeep Kaur, IAS in conference Hall of JMC regarding upgradation of existing and installation of intelligent traffic management system. Sh. Vipin Kumar Choudhary, IGP, Traffic, Joint Commissioner (Adm), R.S. Jamwal (KAS), Asstt. Commissioner (Rev), Executive Engineer (Electric), JMC & Sh. Jatinder Koushiq, CEO, ONNYX, Traffic System, New Delhi was also present in the meeting. A thread bearing discussion was held in meeting which took place in Town Hall, Jammu to discuss installation of intelligent traffic management system in Jammu city. Presently traffic signals have been installed at 30 intersections in Jammu. It was discussed that the present system needs to be upgraded to accommodate traffic lights for pedestrian also.

1. The traffic system would be able to control traffic of each arm of the intersection independently.

2. The traffic signal system would be capable to operate in following modes.

- Blinker mode
- Auto mode
- Manual mode.

3. A central command & control room shall be set up from where the timing & phase of traffic signal would be charged depending on the requirement. The central

room will be able to monitor the functioning of traffic lights in real time using advance technology.

4. Cantilever poles will be used to encourage lane wise driving & traffic signal would also have pedestrian lights which will help people in crossing the road.

5. It was also decided that red light violation detection RLVD will be installed in one location for trail basis. People violating the traffic signals would be issued challans. (ANPR) Automatic Number Plate Recognition System would be used to note the number plate of violations.

**YET ANOTHER PREMISES SEALED IN GANDHI NAGAR BY
