The Enforcement Staff of Jammu Municipal Corporation in compliance of Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir Order No. WP(C) No. 1345/2020, CM No. 4227/2020 and CM No. 4228/2020 dated 01.10.2020 sealed the additional unauthorized construction raised by Ms. Naseema Rashid Wani at Sidhra, Jammu.

Jammu Municipal Corporation had initiated action against the illegal construction raised by the violator in excess of the approved Building Permission under provisions of Control of Building Operation Act, 1988. The matter is presently subjudice in the Hon'ble High Court of J&K.

Municipal authorities once again appeal to all the Jammu City dwellers to refrain from any act of unauthorized construction and requests the general public to support the Municipal Corporation's endeavours to make city organized and clean.

Jammu Municipal Corporation started sanitation drive from Transport Yard

Jammu Municipal Corporation started sanitation drive from 13.10.2020 at Transport Yard, Narwal, Jammu on the directions of Miss Avny Lavasa, IAS, Commissioner, JMC & overall supervision of Miss Tinna Mahajan KAS, Secretary JMC wherein d both men & machinery had been deployed for this special drive.

In total 10 Tippers; 20 no. labour engaged for nallah desiltings & 20 no. SKC's are working during the entire sanitation drive. During the drive, desilting was done in nallah & deep drains falling in the area & huge dumps of garbage also removed so as to give clean & healthy atmosphere & improved sanitation to the general public. Approximately 120 MTP garbage alongwith silt had been removed till now and the drive is still continuing.

JMC laid foundation stone of Ramp Based Multilevel Car Parking

The old Jammu City is presently grappling with the acute problem of not having proper and adequate space for Parking of the vehicles, with the result, the vehicles are parked all along the road side, thus creating frequent traffic jams. The Overall objective of the Construction of Car Parking Facility at Panjtirthi, Jammu, is to bring about decongestion of traffic in the adjoining area of Jammu city by reducing on street parking. This will not only help in providing safe, secure and efficient vehicular circulation /passage but will also enhance public safety & security.

Sh. Chander Mohan Gupta, Mayor, Jammu Municipal Corporation and Adv. Purnima Sharma, Dy. Mayor, in the presence of Ms. Avny Lavasa (IAS), Commissioner, JMC and Councillors as well as other officials today allowed the commencement of work of the construction of Ramp Based Multi-Level Parking at Panjtirthi, Jammu. The Project Cost is Rs. 24.00 Crores and the completion time is 18 Months. The work has been allotted to M/s Vikas & Associates. The Project shall have Parking space for 258 Cars and 136 Two wheelers. There shall be eight levels of Parking including 02 Basements, Ground floor and 04 floors plus Terrace Parking.
