



Commissioner, JMC took stock of Special Sanitation Drive

Ms. Avny Lavasa (IAS), Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation took stock of Special Sanitation Drive launched by Jammu Municipal Corporation in different areas of city. Today she toured the areas viz. Narwal Bye- Pass road, Rajiv Nagar, Nai Basti, Satwari, Gangyal, Nanak Nagar, Marble Market, Trikuta Nagar and Greater Kailash etc. and issued on spot directions to the Dr. Sanjogita Soodan, Health Officer, JMC for putting every possible effort for providing proper sanitation to the citizens of the Jammu City, as the aim for launching this special sanitation drive is to ensure higher cleanliness as the lockdown is gradually lifted.

Commissioner, JMC also directed Transport Officers for thorough cleaning/desilting of the Nallahs well before the onset of monsoon season to avoid over flooding of nallahs during rainy season.

The Commissioner, JMC appealed to the people to cooperate with Jammu Municipal Corporation and use identified places for disposal of garbage. She also stressed to avoid use of polythene to the extent possible which is the major cause of blockage of drains and nallahs. She stressed for putting every possible efforts in achieving goal of making city Jammu Clean & Green and aim of Swachh Bharat Mission and also appealed to the general public at large to comply the guidelines/SOPs being issued by the Govt. with regard to Covid-19 Pandemic in letter and spirit and stay at home and avoid large gatherings in public places and make use of hand sanitizers and masks as preventive measure and also to extend their full cooperation to Jammu Municipal Corporation.

Jammu Municipal Corporation conduct a drive against unauthorized construction in Jammu city.

In continuation to the drives undertaken against the violators in the areas falling within the jurisdiction of Jammu Municipal Corporation limits, the teams headed by Mr. Rajesh Gupta, Chief Enforcement Officer (C.E.O) Enforcement wing of the Jammu Municipal Corporation, While further intensifying its drive against unauthorized construction in Jammu city and its outskirts on the directions of Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation, Ms. Avny Lavasa (IAS) today demolished unauthorized construction which was raised illegally in violation to provisions of Jammu Master Plan, 2032 at Sector-D Extension, Sainik Colony, Jammu. The action has been taken under the provisions of Section 8(1) of the Jammu and Kashmir Control of Building Operation Act, 1988.

It is also pertinent to mention here that JMC has demolished/sealed a number of unauthorized constructions during the recent past in particular to desist violators from raising the constructions without permission/in-violation of the approved building plans which besides violations causing impediment to the plan development of Jammu City.

The Commissioner, JMC further appeal to the general public to refrain from raising illegal constructions and get building plans approved for commercial and residential purpose and raise building according to approved building plan, failing which action as warranted under Jammu and Kashmir Control of Building Operation Act,1988 and Jammu and Kashmir, Municipal Corporation Act,2000 will be taken against the violators including sealing and demolition of the illegal structures.

Commissioner, JMC Ms. Avny Lavasa (IAS) visited the Municipal Animal Care Centre, Roop nagar and took stock of varies activities of the centre.

Commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation Ms. Avny Lavasa (IAS) accompanied by the Municipal Veterinary Officer, Dr. Sushil Kumar Sharma today visited the Municipal Animal Care Centre, Roop nagar and took stock of varies activities of the centre and also visited the site proposed for the construction of Veterinary hospital for the sick and injured stray animals.

Later on Commissioner, JMC chaired a meeting to review the working of Animal Care Centre, Roop Nagar, Jammu wherein Municipal Veterinary Officer and Staff of Municipal Animal Care Centre, Roop Nagar participated. During the course of meeting the Commissioner, JMC insisted to give special focus to ongoing animal birth control programme being carried out by the JMC to control the stray dogs' population in all the 75 wards of JMC. Dr. Indu Bhushan, Dr. Manmeet Singh (Veterinary doctors deployed by the Animal Husbandry Deptt. in the centre) & Dr. Sunil Gautam, ABC Surgeon, FRIENDICOS, SECA were also present in the meeting.

MVO, JMC appraised the commissioner that till date 17,825 nos. of sterilization surgeries to control the stray dogs population under ABC/ARV programme have been conducted by the JMC with the outsourcing of this programme to the implementing agency i.e. FRIENDICOS, SECA (NGO), more than 70% of the stray dogs population will be sterilized with an target oriented approach in the next 1&1/2 years.

It was further apprised that for the time bound redressal of general public complaints regarding rescue of sick and injured stray animals, different teams with rescue vehicles have been constituted who are working round the clock for providing timely treatment in the centre. During the year 2020-2021, 2057 nos. of different kinds of stray animals were rescued and provided treatment in the centre and also 1872 doses of Anti Rabies Vaccination were given to the stray dogs.

Commissioner, JMC also inspected the ongoing construction/repair & renovation work of the centre which has been started by the JMC to strengthen the infrastructure to have all basic treatment facilities for the sick/injured stray animals.

Commissioner, JMC directed the staff to work with dedication and zeal to relieve the suffering of speechless creations by providing best possible treatment to the ailing stray animals in the centre appealed the general public for their cooperation in the successful implementation of ABC/ARV programme within JMC limits. An effective implementation of ABC/ARV programme will not only control the stray dogs population but also curb the spread of rabies both in humans as well as animals, reduce the man dog conflicts/dog bite case & prevent the abuse/cruelty issues of the animals & promote humans & animals health & welfare without causing animal suffering.
