

Resolutions of the 8th General House meeting held on 11-01-2020 at 11:00 AM (Saturday) in the Council Hall of JMC.

- x A Resolution was moved in the “Finance and Planning Standing Committee” meeting held on 10-12-2019 by the Joint Commissioner (Adm.), JMC approved by the Finance and Planning Standing Committee with the deliberations that the matter shall be placed in the next General House meeting for approval of the House. The Hon’ble Mayor Sh. Chander Mohan Gupta put forth the resolution in the General House meeting held on 11-01-2020. The resolution is as under:

1. Release of payments of the contractors in respect of 26 no. of works executed on the same rates, terms and conditions pending since 2017. Committee constituted vide Order No – 153-HUD of 2017 dated 13/12/2017 has recommended the release of payments after examining the fulfillment of all codal formalities.

The Resolution was supported by all the Hon’ble Councillors and passed unanimously by the House.

- x One more Resolution was moved in the “General Functions” Standing Committee meeting held on 10-12-2019 by the Joint Commissioner (Adm.), JMC approved by the General Functions Standing Committee with the deliberations that the matter shall be placed in the next General House meeting for approval of the House. The Hon’ble Mayor Sh. Chander Mohan Gupta put forth the resolution in the General House meeting held on 11-01-2020. The resolution is as under:

1. Forest Land situated at Khanpur, Nagrota was transferred to JMC vide Govt. order No:297/FST of 2010 dated: 28.07.2010, for setting up Modern Abattoir. JMC started the site development work for construction of Modern Abattoir on 25.05.2014 but the locals objected and started agitation against setting up of Modern Abattoir at the site. In the meanwhile in 2016, MOFPI issued instructions to explore the options to upgrade the existing slaughter houses at Gujjar Nagar and Dogra Hall Jammu. As the land at site is lying vacant, we may utilize the same to promote Tourism by establishing facilities for Adventure Tourism through Tourism Department.

The Resolution was supported by all the Hon’ble Councillors and passed unanimously by the House with the deliberations that the matter shall be taken up with the Govt.
